ATTENTION STUDENTS

ACCESSING WIRELESS NETWORKS

For individuals wanting to use the campus wireless network, you will need to connect to “BSC Wireless” as your wireless network connection (see steps below).

1. **Right click** on the wireless icon on the task bar located on the lower right hand corner of your screen
2. Select **“View Available Wireless Networks”**
3. Click on **“Refresh network list”**
4. Select **“BSC Wireless”** from the **“Choose a wireless network”** screen

Guests wanting to use our wireless networking facilities will need to visit the Help Desk (Schafer Hall 129) to acquire login credentials in order to connect to the wireless network.
